CIT Job Description

A CIT is a volunteer position. They are to assist camp counselors in providing a variety of activities to campers in a safe and well supervised environment. They do not have the same responsibility for the campers or for communicating with parents as counselors do.

In addition to working with groups of campers, CITs may also

- Alert the counselor when a parent should be contacted regarding illness, injury or behavior problems and provide the counselor with the details of the situation.
- Help plan and implement daily activities.
- Help keep order and discipline among campers.
- Assist in maintaining a safe environment by supervising campers carefully, understanding and helping campers to follow emergency procedures, and keeping the area clean.
- If a child is hurt or not well you are the one to take that child to the Camp Administrator and the Counselor is to stay with the majority of the children.

Because you are working with children you must always

- Dressed appropriately
- Use appropriate language and gestures.
- Speak and act positively about the camp, campers and staff. (If you have an issue with any of these, please see Lead Counselor)
- Refrain from personal visits
- Refrain from use of your cell phone
